

Using Specific Word Cards

The following lists some ideas for using word cards, specific to each topic:

Calendar and Number Word Cards:

- Practice sorting: the days of the week, the months of the year, the numbers in numerical order.
- Use more than one number card to make higher numbers. Write the new number on paper or practice writing it using a cheque.
- Give abbreviations for calendar words.



Homonym Word Cards:

- Shuffle the cards and match the homonym pairs and trios.
- Give a sentence using a homonym and hold up the corresponding card.
- Print the Homonym sentence list. Shuffle the word cards. Draw one card at a time and use a highlighter to match the homonym on the word card to the one on the word list.
- Find more homonyms to make new word cards.
